Safety Measures For Restarting Worship at St. John's Lutheran, Pinconning, MI

- 1. In person worship every other Sunday for the time being to provide a 14 day automatic quarantine period. Communion is offered at all in-person services. We plan to return to our normal worship schedule in July
- 2. Online worship for the off Sunday's to provide for those who shouldn't or can't attend in person worship.
- 3. For the safety of all, worshipers are required to wear masks.
- 4. Door holders and hand sanitizer will be provided.
- 5. There will be an option to have temperature taken with a non-contact medical thermometer before entry.
- 6. Every other pew will be taped off to promote social distancing.
- 7. Semi-permanent adjustments to the Lord's Supper:
- Continuous line with social distancing.
- Ushers dismiss from pews with social distancing in mind.
- Hand sanitizer to be publicly used by assistants before the congregation is served.
- Pastor and Elder will wear a clear full face shield.
- Gloved assistants dropping wafer into worshipers hands.
- Individual cups only.
- 8. Drop boxes for offerings are at the back of the church since offering plates will not be passed.
- 9. Following worship, elders will dismiss by row to encourage social distancing.
- 10. Pastor will greet outdoors before and after worship with a face mask.
- 11. Extra cleaning measures as well as 14 days between services.
